WHAT IS IT ANYWAY...



Human trafficking is a form of modern-day slavery where people profit from the control and exploitation of others. As defined under U.S. federal law, victims of human trafficking include children involved in the sex trade, adults age 18 or over who are coerced or deceived into commercial sex acts, and anyone forced into different forms of "labor or services," such as domestic workers held in a home, or farmworkers forced to labor against their will.









There are more slaves now than during all the years of the entire transatlantic slave trade combined.








The Number of Human Trafficking Victims Annually.
